To be eligible to go into the draw for a travel grant you must:

- live permanently in Australia
- have an interest in alcohol and pregnancy and Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD)

and meet one of the following criteria:

- Person living with FASD
- Parents or carer of a person living with FASD
- Health professional
- Justice professional
- Education professional (eg. teacher, teaching assistant, special needs assistant)
- Other professional (eg. child protection)
- Service provider (eg. disability services, support worker)
- Researcher
- Student (Masters or PhD)

Travel Grant

Maximum of \$4,000 available in travel grants

Recipients will be reimbursed the following amount on receipt of confirmation of conference registration and travel bookings

Perth metropolitan area

- Registration (Standard registration \$550, Student/Parent & Carer/Person living with FASD \$400.00)

Greater Perth (outside Perth metropolitan area eg. Mandurah, Lancelin)

- Registration (Standard registration \$550, Student/Parent & Carer/Person living with FASD \$400.00 + \$200 toward travel)

Regional & Remote Western Australia

- \$1,000 towards registration & travel

Other states & territories

- \$1,000 towards registration & travel
